

Fischbach investigates more sustainable packaging solution

Fischbach produces packaging for the silicon and adhesive industry. This international company with a branch in Temse makes injection moulded tubes that are subsequently printed on. The company explored the possibilities of sustainable packaging alternatives.

In cooperation with Sirris the packaging process of the tubes was optimised. The company investigated whether there were more sustainable alternatives for cardboard packaging. The idea was to develop a returnable packaging, in consultation with the customer. Fischbach could rely on the extensive technical and market knowledge of Sirris engineers, which the company does not have in-house.
